

## REGISTRATION

If you wish to send your child to **Lower Providence Presbyterian Preschool** for the 2012-2013 school year, please return the following as soon as possible to Lois Mason, Preschool Director.

1. Enclosed registration form with your 1st and 2nd choices.
2. A \$40 application fee is due at time of application. Once a child is assigned to a class, the application fee is **not refundable**.

*You will be notified immediately if your 1st or 2nd choice are not available. Your registration fee will be returned and your child's name will be added to our WAITING LIST.*

## TUITION

**Our monthly fees are:**

**\$115 for 2 day classes**

**\$140 for 3 day classes**

**\$195 for Pre-Kindergarten class**

Tuition is due by the 20th of each month, **September's tuition is due by June 1st.** Make checks payable to Lower Providence Presbyterian Preschool.

There will be no refunds for time lost because of holidays, absence of the child, weather or other emergency closings.

A one month notice is required for withdrawing your child from the program.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To enroll in the Three Year Old program, your child must be 3 by September 1st and must be toilet trained. This is a good indicator of readiness for pre-school.

To enroll in the Four Year Old program your child must be 4 years of age by September 1st.

To enroll in the Pre-Kindergarten program, your child must have completed a four year old program or be recommended.

All Children are welcome, regardless of religious affiliation, race or creed.

**Lower Providence Presbyterian Preschool** is a non-profit co-operative organization which provides an educational program for preschool children.

The preschool currently serves children from the surrounding community. The school is governed by a Director certified in Early Childhood Education and the church advisory committee. The classes are taught by certified teachers and assisted by a teacher aide.

The three and four year old programs have a co-op parent program. Parents are assigned days throughout the year to volunteer in their child's classroom. This allows the family to become involved with their child's learning process and helps to keep our tuition cost low.

The children in the four year old and pre-kindergarten programs have the opportunity to explore the Spanish language through a Spanish teacher. All the classes are introduced to Sign Language by a specialized teacher.

The purpose of the Preschool is to provide children with a quality educational program grounded in Christian values. We guide the children to develop as individuals by helping them achieve the objectives below.

**The teachers at Lower Providence Presbyterian Preschool will guide your child to achieve the following objectives:**

- **Acquire a joyful desire to learn**
- **Respond to adults other than their parents**
- **Develop the skills to socially interact with other children**
- **Achieve a sense of self-worth**
- **Respect him/herself, his/her classmates and the surrounding community**
- **Feel safe and secure in a school atmosphere**
- **Express feelings in an appropriate manner**
- **Be sensitive to the feelings of others**
- **Develop skills of listening, comprehension, visual discrimination, reasoning and self expression**
- **Learn about their environment**
- **Increase fine and gross motor skills through developmentally appropriate activities**
- **Achieve the readiness skills required for entrance into Kindergarten**

## PRESBYTERIAN PRESCHOOL

### Three Year Olds

The three year old co-op classes are limited to 16 children each. The co-op aspect of the program means that each parent helps in the classroom about once every six weeks. These two and three day programs combine a period of free play with more structured activities: story time, circle time, outdoor play, gym, games, art, music, and field trips. The Three Year Old classes are offered on M - W - F 9:00 to 11:30 and T - TH 9:00 to 11:30 and T-TH 12:30—3:00 PM

### Four Year Olds

There are three four year old co-op classes that are limited to 16 children each. The co-op aspect of the program means that each parent helps in the classroom five times a year. The program offers structured activities to aid in kindergarten readiness. Art, music, free play, outdoor play, and field trips are provided to complement these activities. Our program enhances the child's physical, mental, and emotional growth. The Four Year Old classes are M - W - F 9:00 to 11:30, T - W - TH 9:00 to 11:30 and M - T - TH 12:30 to 3:00.

### Pre-Kindergarten

This class is specifically designed for those children who have completed a four year old preschool program but need another year to "grow" in maturity and/or skills before entering kindergarten. We use the alphabet and authentic children's literature as our guide. We will challenge the children by enriching their knowledge, and exposing them to many different areas of learning. The class is limited to 14 children and meets 9:00 to 11:30 on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday.
