If your child isn't feeling well or feeling at their best:

PLEASE DO NOT SEND THEM TO SCHOOL!

We depend on you, the parents, to assist us in maintaining a safe and healthy environment for all the children. We reserve the right to send any student home who shows signs of illness at school.

We desire for our students and staff to be healthy and our preschool classes thriving. It is difficult to learn when you are ill.

If your child develops a fever: 100 degrees or more

- They must be fever free for 24 hours and not be on any fever reducing medicine to attend school.
- Stomach upset/diarrhea/vomiting, do not return until 24 hours have past.
- ANY signs of wet cough, heavy nasal discharge, sore throat... your child must stay at home until all symptoms have cleared.

Please notify your teacher if your child will be absent and the reason.
